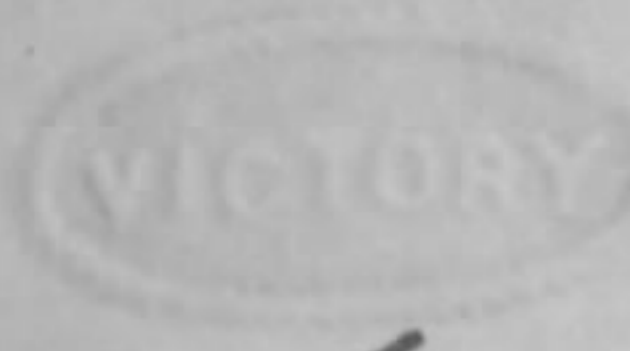

In the claim of Rebecca Johnson widow of Harmon B. for an increase of pension on Nov. 7th 1868, the applicant alleges the age of William Henry in her original declaration dated May 23rd 1863, as 13 years, of Annette Belle as 4 years, while in her application for an increase of pension, the names and dates of births appear as follows: William Henry born May 13th 1833 Annette born Nov. 9th 1861.
