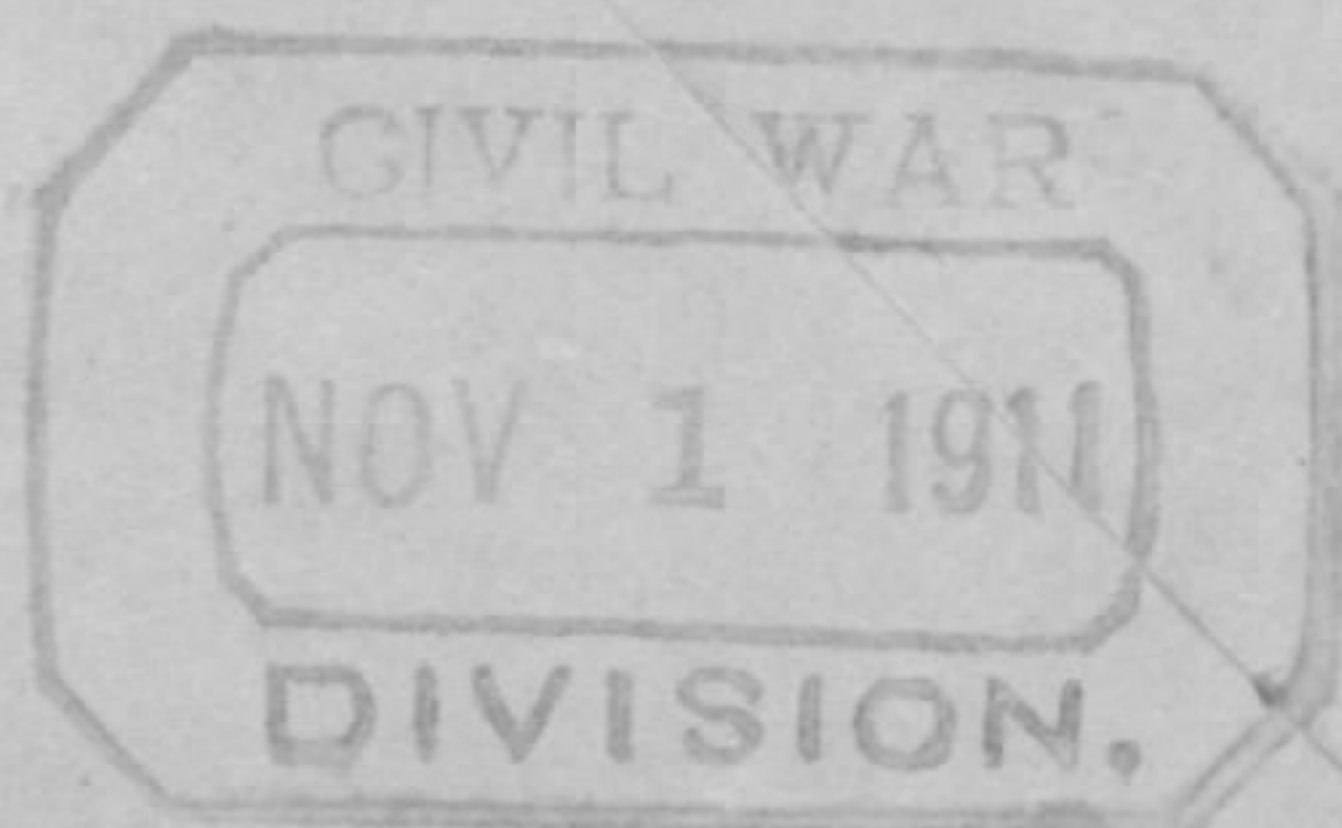

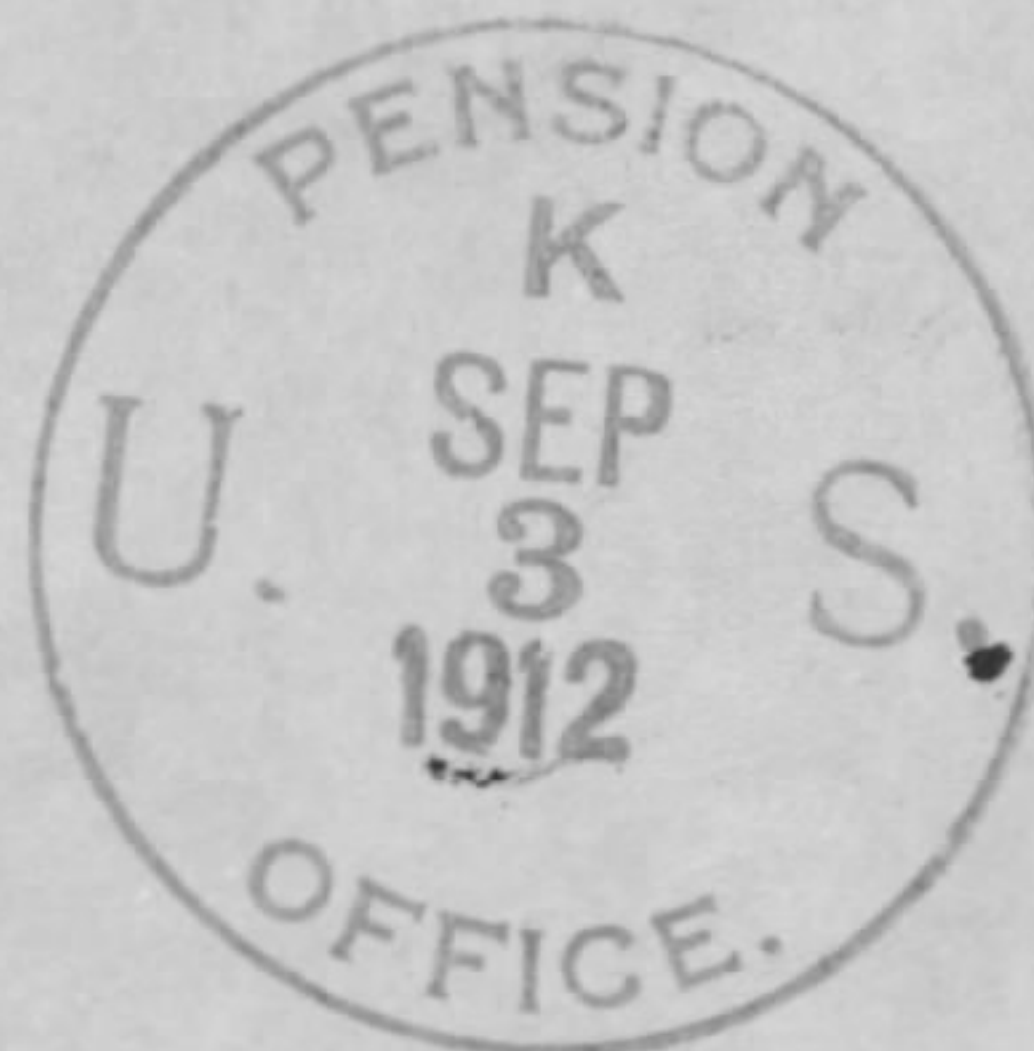
Madam:


