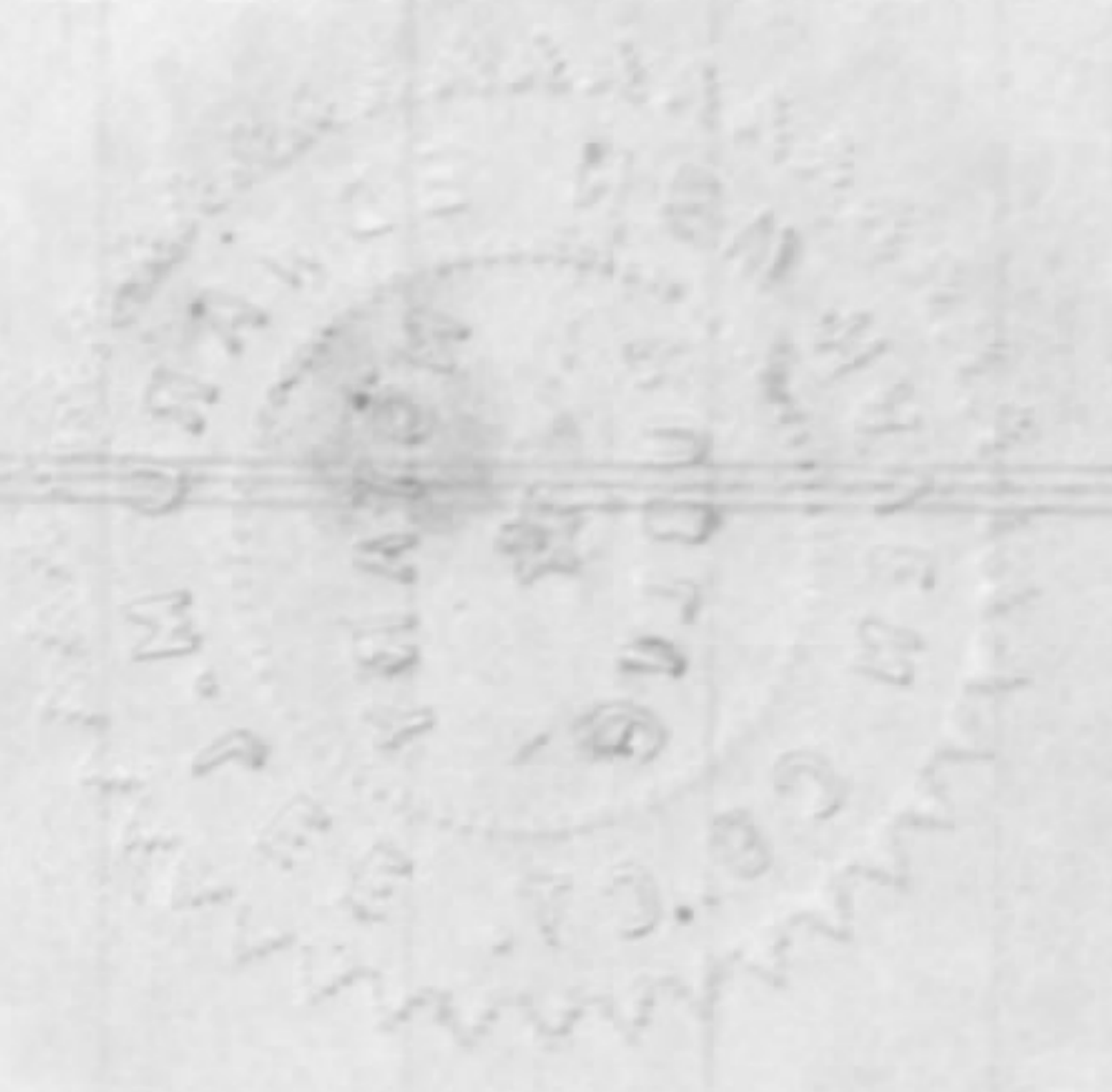

I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt from your Office of application for Pension No. 109,706, and to return it herewith, with such information as is furnished by the files of this Office.

It appears from the Rolls on file in this Office, that Richard S. Hull was enrolled on the 7th day of Aug., 1862, at New Haven Ct in Co. I, 14th Regiment of Conn. Volunteers, to serve three years, or during the war, and mustered into service as a Corporal on the 23rd day of Aug. 1862, at Hartford, Ct., in Co. I, 14th Regiment of Conn. Volunteers, to serve three years, or during the war. On the Muster Roll of Co. I of that Regiment, for the months of Nov. and Dec. 1862, he is reported "Killed in action at Antietam Sept. 17th 1862"
