NOTE.—Payment of pension will not be transferred to an agency within the district of which the pensioner does not permanently reside. The pension certificate must accompany an application for transfer. In applications of Guardians the names of the wards and of the soldier must be inserted. If the pension agent personally knows the magistrate before whom the application is sworn to, or has on file at the agency a certificate of the authority of said magistrate, the certificate of the agent as to his official character is sufficient; otherwise, the same must be duly certified. The interposition of an attorney in securing a transfer is unnecessary.
