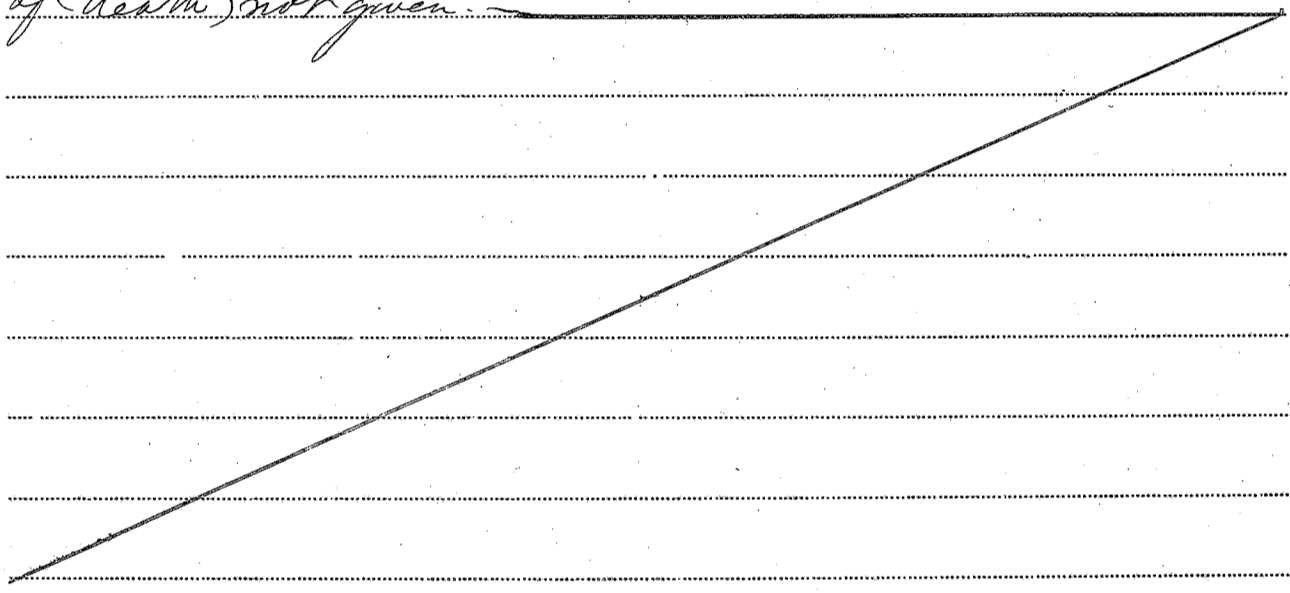

It appears from the records filed in this Office, that *1st Lieut Richard H. Fowler,*
Co. A, 24th Conn. Vol., was wounded in action at *Fredricks-*
burg, Va., Dec. 13, 1862, - Compound fracture tibia and fibula, - am-
putation, and died *Dec. 14, 1862,* of *exsanguination;* place
of death, not given.
