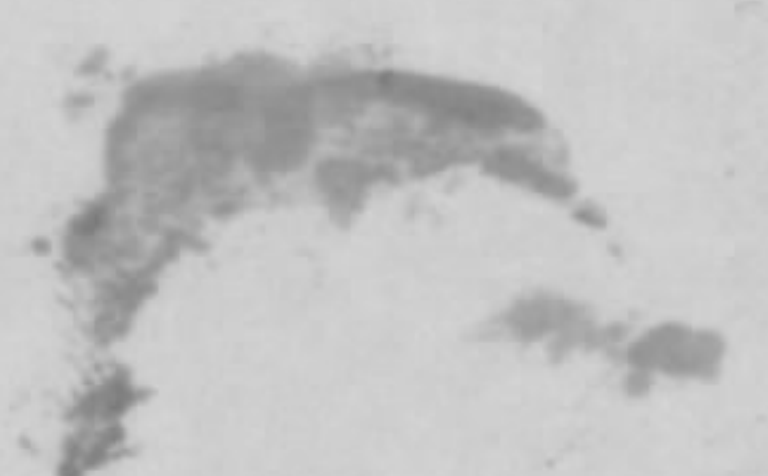

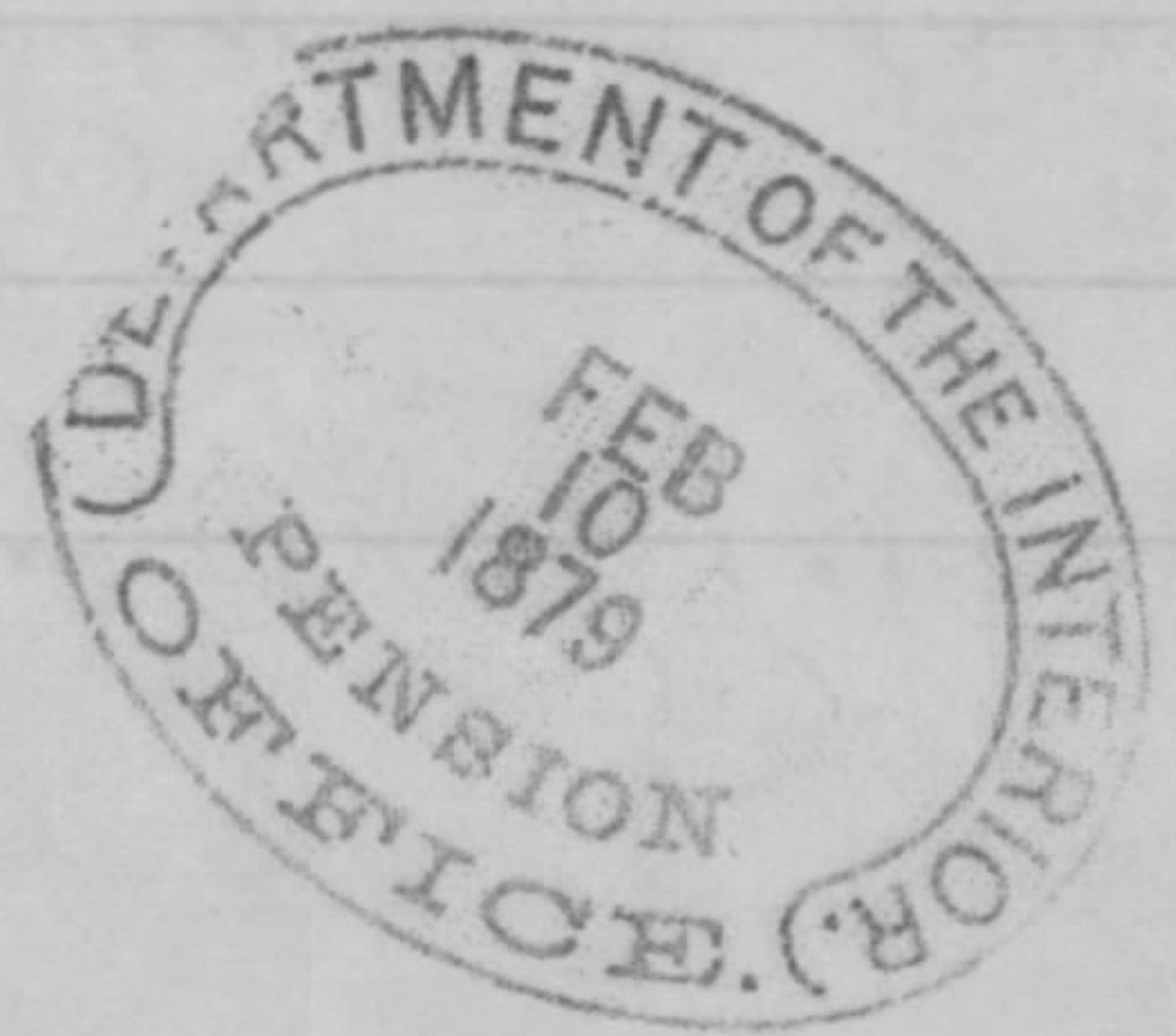

On this 2^d day of January one thousand eight hundred & 75, before me a Commissioner of the Superior Court for said County, duly authorized to administer oaths for general purposes in said County, personally appeared Mrs. Maria L. Dolph widow of William H. Dolph who being duly questioned and sworn deposes and says that she is a claimant for a pension as the widow of said William H. Dolph and that her claim (as by information from Pension Office appears) is No 136,732 and that the declaration in said claim gives the name of her husband as William Dolph while in the marriage evidence it appears as William H. Dolph which she further says is an error as her said husband was always known by the name of William H. Dolph and never known as William Dolph and further that the person who wrote said declaration for her must have omitted to insert the (H) in stating his name as William Dolph as she says she distinctly recollects that she gave her said husband's name at the time as William H. Dolph and in this manner only as at present she remembers and she explains the aforesaid discrepancy in the name of her said husband
