I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt from your Office of application for Pension No. 11,375, and to return it herewith, with such information as is furnished by the files of this Office.

It appears from the Rolls on file in this Office, that Benjamin R. Dowd was enrolled on the 11th day of August, 1862, at New Braford in Co. "K", 15th Regiment of Conn Volunteers, to serve three years, or during the war, and mustered into service as a Private on the 25th day of August, 1862, at New Haven, Conn, in Co. "K", 15th Regiment of Conn Volunteers, to serve three years, or during the war. On the Muster Roll of Co. "K" of that Regiment, for the months of Nov & December, 1862, he is reported as Died at Private Residence in Washington City December 4th 1862. Cause of death not stated, no further records on file.
