On the 30<sup>th</sup> of March, he was forwarded to his Regt, as the Govt Authorities supposed, but was by some mistake sent to New Orleans instead of to Newport News Va. where his Regt was stationed. On arriving at New Orleans, the Authorities there ascertained the mistake, & sent him back to New York again. He then voluntarily returned to Bedloe's Island & being still unfit for duty, is under Medical treatment.

His name is Lewis W. Blatchley Jr. 15<sup>th</sup> Regt

Connecticut Vols.

His Father is very anxious that he should be allowed to go home for a few days on furlough, and requests me to make such an application. If consistent with your views I would respectfully request that he might be allowed a few days absence - and shall be gratified if such be accorded him.
