On this 2^d day of October AD 1866
personally appeared before me Judge of
the Probate Court for the District of Madison
Ellen A. Clements a resident of Madison in the
County of New Haven & State of Connecticut aged
30. years who being first duly sworn according
to law doth on her oath make the following
declaration, in order to obtain the benefit
of the provision made by the second section
of the act of Congress increasing the pensions
of widows & orphans approved July 25th 1866

That she is the widow of Nathan C. Clements
who was a Corporal in Company G, Commanded
by Capt Samuel D. Willard in the 14th Regiment
of Connecticut Coos, in the war of 1861. and that
by reason of his death in the service aforesaid
she has been granted a pension of eight dollars
per month in accordance with a Certificate
numbered 26,498 bearing date July 15th 1864

She further swears that she has the
following named Children of her deceased husband
& herself under sixteen years of age who are now
living the dates of whose birth were as given
below to wit, Millie Nathan Born August
31st 1852, Emma Augusta Born March 1st
1854

She further declares that she has not remarried since the death of her said husband nor has she abandoned the support of any one of the Children above named nor permitted any one of the ~~Children~~ same to be adopted by any other person or persons as his her or their Child
