I have the honor to acknowledge the receipt from your Office of application for Pension No. 136, 732, and to return it herewith, with such information as is furnished by the files of this Office.

It appears from the Rolls on file in this Office, that William H. Dolph was enrolled on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1862, at Guilford in Co. "G", 15<sup>th</sup> Regiment of Conn Volunteers, to serve 3 years, or during the war, and mustered into service as a Pvt on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of August 1862, at Camp Terry, Ct, in Co. "G", 15<sup>th</sup> Regiment of Conn Volunteers, to serve 3 years, or during the war. On the Muster Roll of Co. "G" of that Regiment, for the months of March and April 1863, he is reported "Died in Regt's Hospital April 17, 63, of Erysipelas." No similar name borne on rolls of said Company on file in this Office,
