Beaton born inin the State of Cannetic aged 19 _____years, and by occupation mulant DO HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE to have voluntarily enlisted this 2120 day of_______ 1862, as a soldier in a Volunteer Regiment of Connecticut, to serve the UNITED STATES FOR THREE YEARS, OR DURING THE WAR with persons owing allegiance to and in open rebellion to the United States Government, unless sooner discharged by proper authority; and to be subject to orders from the Federal Government; do also agree to accept such bounty, pay, rations, and clothing, as are, or may be established by law. Juil & Beatin do solemnly swear, that I will bear true faith and allegience to the United States of America, and that I will serve them honestly and faithfully against all their enemies or opposers whomsoever; and that I will observe and obey the orders of the President of the United States, and the orders of the officers appointed over me, according to the Rules and Articles for the government of the armies of the United States. worn and subscribed to, at C Benton FORE__ otan Public 1 CERTIFY ON HONOR, That I have carefully examined the above named Recruit, agreeably to the General Regu lations of the Army, and that in my opinion he is free from all bodily defects and mental infirmity, which would, in any way, disqualify him from performing the duties of a soldier.Examining Surgeon. I CERTIFY ON HONOR, That I have minutely inspected the Recruit ful C. Scutton previously to his enlistment, and that he was entirely sober when enlisted; that to the best of my judgment and belief he is of lawful age; and that in accepting him as duly qualified to perform the duties of an able bodied soldier, I have strictly observed the Regulations which govern the Recruiting service. This soldier has being eyes, hair. Recruiting Officer. DIRECTIONS .- This enlistment must be signed and acknowledged in triplicates, one copy to be sent to the Adjutant-

General; one to the commander of the regiment, and one copy to be retained by the recruiting officer; the copy to the Adjutant-General must be sent immediately after being signed; the oath must be sworn and subscribed to before a Justice of the Peace or Notary Public.
