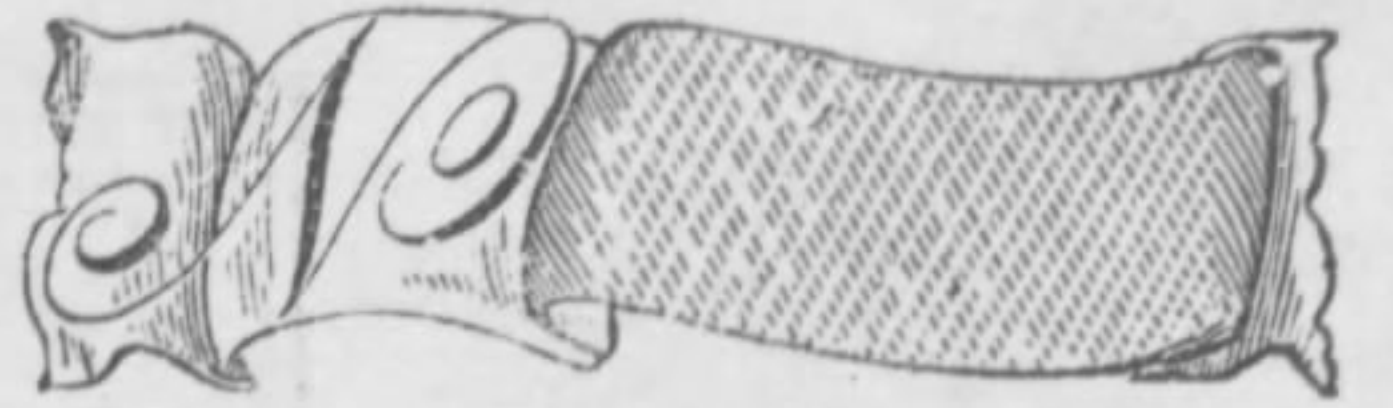

A. D. 1863, personally appeared before
me Arthur D. Osborne Clerk
of the Superior Court for New Haven County,
Lavinia S. Tibbals a resident of

New Haven in the County of New Haven and State of Connecticut
aged Thirty Seven years, who being first duly sworn according to
law, doth on her oath make the following declaration, in order to obtain the benefit of the provision
made by the Act of Congress, approved July 14th, 1862, that she is the widow of Abraham
Tibbals who was a Private in Company K,
commanded by Benjamin S. Jepson in the Tenth Regiment of
Connecticut Volunteers in the War of 1861, who died at Newbern N.C. on the
6th day of August, of Typhoid fever as she is informed - that she has two children only
to wit Celestia Seward Tibbals born March 23rd 1853, and Amos Fowler Tibbals
born June 27th 1858 both now residing with her in New Haven
She further declares that she was married to the said Abraham Tibbals at New Haven Ct.
on the ~~29th~~ 29th or 30th day of May in the year 1848 that her husband
the aforesaid Abraham Tibbals died on the day above mentioned
and that she has remained a widow ever since that period, as will more fully appear by reference to
the proof hereto annexed. She also declares that she has not, in any manner, been engaged in, or
aided or abetted the rebellion in the UNITED STATES.

no interest in the prosecution of this claim.
