On the 11<sup>th</sup> day of July 1864, personally appeared before me Wm. L.

RANSOM Clerk of the Superior Court for the County of Litchfield and State of Connecticut Garwood Sawford a resident of the town of Litchfield and State of Connecticut aged 69 years, who being first duly sworn according to law, doth in oath make the following declaration as guardian of the Minor Children of Richard Fowler deceased, in order to obtain the benefits of the provisions made by the act of Congress approved Granting half pay to the Minor Children under 16 years of age of deceased officers and Soldiers; that he is the guardian of Ellen L. Fowler aged 15 years and Garwood S. Fowler aged 10 years, whose father was a Sergeant in Co. A of the 27<sup>th</sup> Regt Conn. Vols. that the said Richard Fowler did die at Guilford Va. on or about the 17<sup>th</sup> day of December 1862, that the mother of the children aforesaid died on or about the 8<sup>th</sup> day of December 1863, and that the date of the birth of said children was as follows, ~~to wit~~, ages - See application

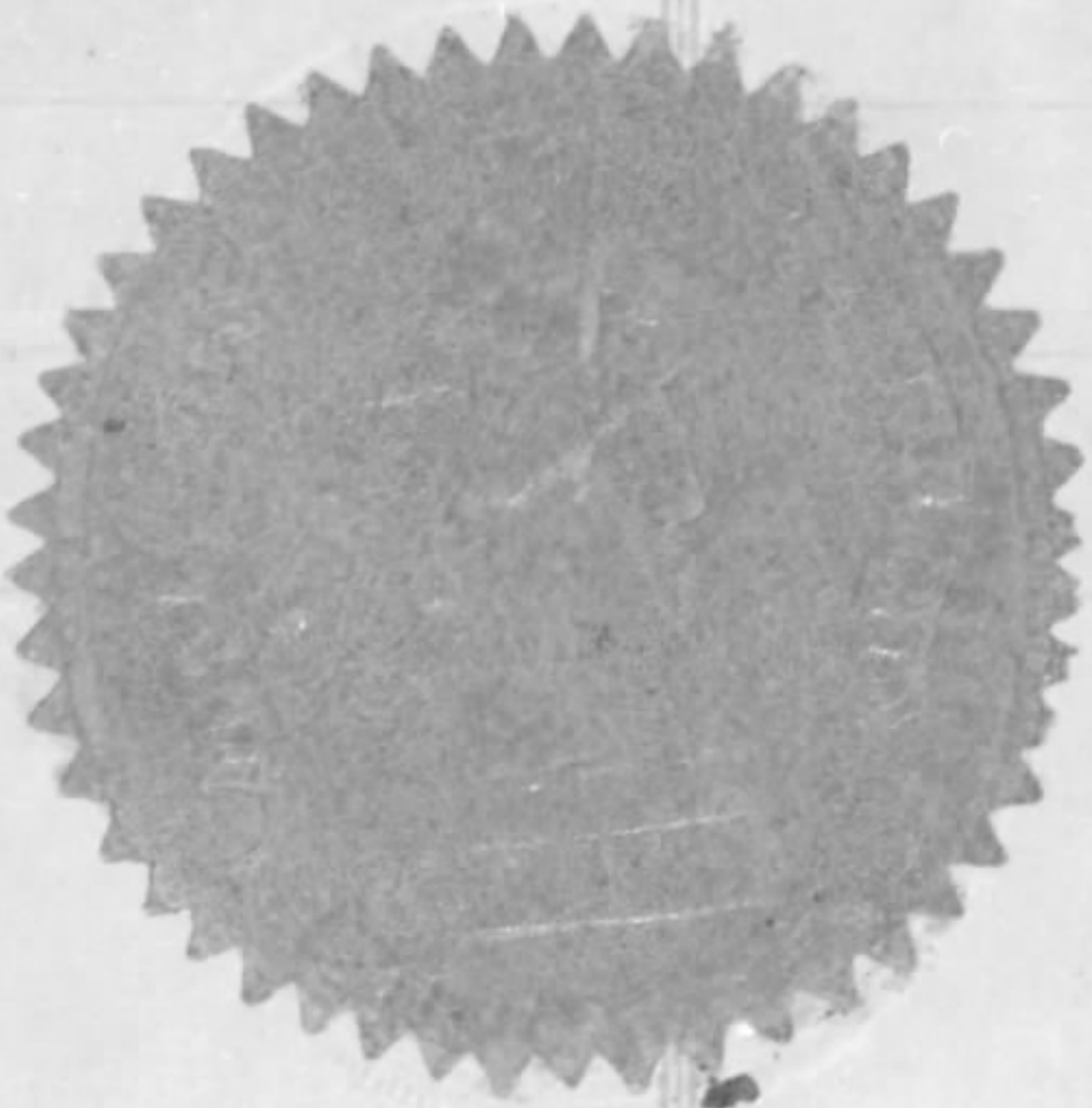
