Aug 1862, as a **Soldier** in a Volunteer Regiment of Connecticut, to serve the **UNITED STATES FOR THREE YEARS, OR DURING THE WAR** with persons owning allegiance to and in open rebellion to the United States Government, unless sooner discharged by proper authority; and to be subject to orders from the Federal Government; do also agree to accept such bounty, pay, rations, and clothing, as are, or may be established by law.

And I, *Charles W Benton* do solemnly swear, that I will bear true faith and allegiance to the **United States of America**, and that I will serve them honestly and faithfully against all their enemies or opposers whomsoever; and that I will observe and obey the orders of the President of the United States, and the orders of the officers appointed over me, according to the Rules and articles for the government of the armies of the United States.
